Course Attendance Logistics



Similar to attendance to other Enterasys Technical Training courses, the same basic registration and enrollment acknowledgement applies with a few minor changes. Below is an overview of the enrollment process.

- Student registers for Virtual Class by selecting the applicable course via the following link: <http://www.enterasys.com/services-training/courses.aspx>
- Upon completion of registration process, student will receive confirmation of class registration via automatic email notification from Enterasys. The confirmation email will contain information regarding the course selected, the specific class that the student registered for, and the technical requirements for attending the Virtual Classroom session.
- The Instructor will then email the student introducing him / herself as the instructor for the class. He/she will provide the student with the following: instructor session ID (presentation) and individual lab access session ID (hands-on lab) that they will be using, the conference bridge information (for the audio portion), and a quick overview of the requirements for accessing the Virtual Classroom.
- Prior to the start of the class, the student will receive a second email containing the following information: personal session ID Information for performing the hands-on lab portion of the course, instructor session ID information for viewing the lecture presentation information, an attendance roster, and conference bridge access code for logging in for the lecture portion of the course.

Virtual Classroom – Connection Requirements

In order to ensure successful attendance and participation in your Virtual Class, please review the Connection Requirements listed below.

Connection Requirements

- PC or MAC
- Windows XP, Vista, 7, or MAC OS X
- Web browser (Enterasys recommends either Firefox 2/3 or Internet Explorer 7/8)
- JavaScript needs to be enabled
- Telephone connection (for the lecture component of the class)
- Hi-speed Internet connection (minimum DSL or cable modem)
