

**Enterasys Networks**  
**Statement of 508 Compliance**

Enterasys Networks products are exempt for Section 508 per authority of § 1194.3(f): “Products located in spaces frequented only by service personnel for maintenance, repair, or occasional monitoring of equipment are not required to comply with this part.” The limited informational or functional interactions/interfaces that our products have with workers in office spaces thus are exempt as originating from, and pertaining to, products in § 1194.3(f) spaces.

Despite this categorical exemption, Enterasys chooses to meet the technical standards of §§ 1194.21-1194.41. We believe that we do so in most instances. Enterasys self-contained, closed products comply with § 1194.25. The functional performance criteria of § 1194.31 are met. Enterasys documentation and support comply with § 1194.41. One product, NetSight software, has some features that are not exempted from 508 standards; a VPAT is under construction but not yet complete; it will set forth the details showing partial compliance.

Therefore, Enterasys Networks certifies compliance with the following solicitation requirement, or similar solicitation requirements:

*“All electronic and information technology (EIT) procured through this Statement of Work/ Bill of Materials and any resulting contract, task order, delivery order, or purchase order must meet the applicable accessibility standards at 36 CFR 1194, unless an agency exception to this requirement exists. 36 CFR 1194 implements Section 508 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended, and is viewable here. The contractor shall indicate for each line item in the schedule whether each product or service is compliant or noncompliant with the accessibility standards at 36 CFR 1194. Further, the proposal must indicate where full details of compliance can be found (e.g., vendor's website or other exact location).”*
